

## TRANSFER POLICY

- The academic residency policy states that the last 30 semester hours (sh) leading to the baccalaureate degree must be completed at Youngstown State University. A minimum of 16 sh comprising the major in the baccalaureate degree must be earned in residence. A minimum of 21 sh of upper-division credit for the baccalaureate degree must be earned in residence.

## ALL STUDENTS

**Students are classified by the number of semester hours completed. The table below shows your status:**

<b>00-31 sh</b>	<b>Freshman</b>
<b>32-63 sh</b>	<b>Sophomore</b>
<b>64-95 sh</b>	<b>Junior</b>
<b>96+ sh</b>	<b>Senior</b>

- University policy states that students **may not use** credit by exam to fulfill the last 30 sh of credit toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Always check course for prerequisites before registering! Students will not receive credit for a course that is a prerequisite for a more advanced course which the student has already successfully completed.
- Students seeking a BA will need to declare a minor in addition to the major. Consult with your department advisor. The minimum number of hours required for the minor is 18 semester hours. One third of the hours for the minor must be at the upper division level. Consult with your advisor for suggestions.
- As of fall 1997, the University requirement for the number of upper division course work hours is 48 semester hours. Upper division course work is that which is taken at the Junior and Senior levels (3xxx, 4xx, 5xxx).
- The minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) required for **Good Standing is 2.00** after two consecutive terms on warning will be suspended for one academic term before reinstatement on warning. For additional suspension information check the Undergraduate Bulletin.
- Students who have completed at least 15 sh and have a minimum grade point average of 2.00 may elect to take one class per term on a credit/no credit basis (CR/NC). This option may be elected for a maximum of 12 semester hours.
